Kryal Castle

Is there really a 700 year old castle on a hill outside Ballarat, just one hour from Melbourne? Kryal Castle is, in truth, only a 40 year old theme park, but it is a well-executed one following a multi-million dollar redevelopment. Reopened in March 2013 as Kryal Castle Adventure Park and Resort, this is Australia' only medieval adventure park, and recreates a legendary land of myths and medieval adventure with knights, dragons, wizards, kings, queens, princesses and fairies.

Sovereign Hill

It's just like stepping back in time to gold rush Ballarat during the 1850s - from the hustle and bustle of Main Street where costumed ladies and gents parade their new-found wealth, to the excitement of the Red Hill Gully Diggings where visitors pan for real gold and it's 'finders keepers'!

Visitors can see a \$150,000 gold pour, ride in a horse-drawn carriage and watch street performers, including the Redcoat Soldiers who march and drill before firing their muskets. Along Main Street, there are shops selling 1850s-style goods, hotels and schools to visit, and a theatre with goldfields entertainment. For the adventurous, there are underground mine tours with an inclined tramway ride. And those with a special interest in 19th century trades can chat with skilled craftsmen at work in the blacksmith's forge, the candle works, the wheelwright's plant, the coachbuilder's and the confectionery factory.

By night, Sovereign Hill presents its spectacular, multi-million dollar sound-and-light show, 'Blood on the Southern Cross' - the legendary story of the 1854 Eureka Uprising, a great Australian drama.

It has a number of iconic objects such as the evocative 159 -year-old Eureka

Flag but most of the collection is digital. The contemporary museum offers a range of innovative education programs and is a showcase of rich, layered,

James McKain Meek was a pioneer of the Ballarat gold fields, where he ran a store and soda water factory, and lived subsequently at Warrnambool and New Zealand. A skilled draughtsman, he delighted in exercising his skill in miniature penmanship and through his life produced a series of large, intricate drawings to commemorate aspects of local history and to promote the colony of Victoria.
